



6 PACK INDOOR CRICKET RULES

Laws of the game follow the 8 per side rules;

With the following exceptions.

- A team consists of a maximum of six players per team and a minimum of four players for a game to proceed.
- 18 overs per innings
- Each batting pair bats for 6 overs.
- Each player must bowl 1 over to each batting pair.
- The court is divided into thirds by redlines.
- 2 fielders only in each third until bowler has released the ball.
- Minus 6 runs for a wicket
- Batters can be caught off the back net if the ball hits the 13 square.
- The scoring zones are higher.
- The highest batting partnership for the game, regardless of if you win or lose, receives six free drink cards from the umpire on completion of the match subject to your team being financial.

Please pay particular attention to the following Rules which apply to every version of Indoor Cricket played at Top End Indoor Sports.

RULE 19 – MISCONDUCT

- Top End Indoor Sports has zero tolerance regarding unsportsmanlike behaviour, abusive or threatening behaviour or language, or physical abuse of another player, staff member or equipment.

RULE 20 - ORDER OFF

- Umpires may order players from the field if they deem their actions to be 'misconduct'.
- A player sent from the field is to leave the centre immediately and not return for 12 weeks.
- Upon the players return, if they are sent off again, they will receive a life ban from Top End Indoor Sports.
